





# LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP

## *A Call for Entries*





### SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Mississippi's First Alumnae Association's Legacy Scholarship is awarded to one family member of an alumna/us who has been admitted to MUW as a new, full-time student. The Legacy Scholarship is the amount equivalent to one semester's in-state tuition at MUW. MFAeA Legacy Scholarship selection will be based on the students potential for academic and leadership success at MUW. Those eligible for the Legacy Scholarship will be considered in this order:

-  I The child\*, grandchild, niece, nephew, or sibling\* of an alumna/us  
\*“Child” includes step-children; “Sibling” includes half or step siblings.
-  II The daughter-in-law or son-in-law, the great-grandchild, great niece or nephew, or a cousin of an alumna/us

### APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications should be submitted to the MFAeA Scholarship Chair by March 30, 2010 for the following fall semester. Must be postmarked by that date. Applications should include:

-  I Student's complete resume, including academic achievements, extracurricular activities, and work and volunteer activities.
-  II Letter describing why she or he has decided to attend MUW
-  III Letter of recommendation from the alumna/us sponsoring the applicant
-  IV Letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or counselor.

**MFAeA Scholars must maintain full-time enrollment and a quality point average of a 3.0.**
